



A Tradition of Excellence



According to VHS head football coach, Lee Smith, Victoria has a great football tradition. Perhaps that is why Smith has chosen "A Tradition of Excellence" as the team's motto. He says it is that tradition that has made his move to Victoria an easy one. He has felt support from the community already and considers that support one of the rewards of being in a small western Kansas town.

Lee Smith grew up in Haven, Kansas, and was hired as a math teacher after the 2000 fall semester. He gratefully accepted the teaching job and was elated to hear there was a head football coaching job available. The head coaching job made the offer a real attraction for him.

Smith hopes to make a difference in the lives of his students and athletes. He enjoys working with kids and has always wanted to coach. His enthusiasm for coaching and desire for working with kids has become evident this summer. Smith has opened the weight room twice a day, four times a week. Numbers have been positive. There have been 20 boys on average and up to 9 girls at times. He believes part of the weight program's success has been due to the fact that he runs it with a team approach. Everything is done as a team, including the 30-minute conditioning done at the beginning of each session. Smith has also opened the weight room up to middle school athletes.

Smith ran a weeklong camp for 3rd thru 6th graders and another for 7th and 8th graders. He was impressed with the effort put out by both age groups. Summer camp for the high school program consisted of a weekend stay at the high school. His projected number of players for the 2001 season is 32.

Smith's goals for this season are to get the kids excited about the sport and to get the most out of his players' abilities. He has been impressed with the hard work he has seen already. He believes the football team will be successful by going out each week and competing. Smith wants his players to not be satisfied with mediocre. He expects each player to play his hardest.

Spectators can look forward to seeing the Knights play POWER football. Smith likes the running game and knows his team will be a physical one. Knight football will begin with a home opener Friday, August 31, at 7:00PM. Completing the team are Smith's two assistants. Bob Leikam brings much experience to the team and will coach the defensive backs and wide receivers. Chris Windholz '90, Victoria alum, will be the defensive coordinator and will coach the linemen.

Spectators will also see the Knights will be sporting new uniforms this season. They will wear maroon at home and gold away. Their jerseys will be completed with maroon pants and helmets. A new Knight insignia will also be worn on the helmet. Smith's hope for his players is that they will believe in themselves and their abilities. If so, he is confident that the "tradition of excellence" will continue.
