Her husband, Steve Ryan, was the principal of the Victoria schools from 1954-1961 and then returned to become the first superintendent of the newly organized school district #432 in 1967-1969. After retirement, they moved to Topeka. Their son, Pat graduated from Victoria High School with the class of 1957. Mrs. Ryan died June 20, 1998. Pat will represent his mother during the homecoming festivities.

Mr. Raymond Schulte '47 will be honored for his many years of service and dedication to the students of Victoria High School. He was a teacher at Victoria from 1957-1981. He taught typing, shorthand, and bookkeeping. Mr. Schulte's wife Leona, taught music at Victoria Elementary School for many years. They have four children; Doug '84, Alan '85, Marthann '91 and John '96 all graduates of Victoria High School. Mr. Schulte retired from teaching in 1981. He and his wife live in the country near Walker and he keeps busy on the family farm.

Mr. Doug Moeckel won the respect of his students while a teacher in the Victoria school system and will be the third and final recipient for this year's award. Mr. Moeckel taught at the middle school and the high school from 1981-1988. He taught P.E. and coached football, basketball, and track. Mr. Moeckel and his wife, Deb, live in Ellsworth where he is serving as superintendent of the Ellsworth school district. They have two sons, Stewart and Ben.

Mr. Schulte, Mr. Moeckel, and Pat Ryan will serve as our Grand Marshals for the homecoming parade and will receive special recognition at Saturday night's banquet. 
