### **HALL OF FAME 2008**

### FRANK WINDHOLZ ~ MARGE ROME ~ BERNADETTE ROTH YOUNGER

It is with great pleasure and an honor that I present to you the three following candidates named to the Victoria Alumni Hall of Fame for 2008. Those three members are Frank Windholz, Marge Rome, and Bernadette Roth Younger. I have been influenced by all three people, and each is linked to the other in some way. Marge and Det are classmates and good friends who are celebrating their 50-year reunion this year, and they both had Frank Windholz as their high school English teacher. I have worked with Marge and Det for years in various organizations, and I also had Frank Windholz for a speech and English teacher. I will never forget those infamous words from Mr. Windholz upon my return to visit VHS after my college education that allowed me to teach English. With a disbelieving and 'what's this world coming to' look, he uttered the words, "YOU'RE an English teacher"????

FRANK WINDHOLZ earned both a bachelor's and a master's degree from Fort Hays State University. He taught English, Latin, and Spanish, and was the librarian at St. Joseph's Military Academy in Hays. After that, he taught for four years in Arnhold, KS. It was in the spring of 1957, Frank Windholz accepted a job at Victoria High School as an English, Spanish, speech, and debate teacher. During the last few years of his career at VHS, Frank worked as the school's full-time librarian. After retiring at the age of 62, he worked full time on helping families and towns research their genealogies. Frank enjoyed fishing and playing cards, but his greatest passion was reading. His sincerity and knowledge of the subject matter he was teaching was always evident in the classroom. Frank passed away on November 23, 1997. He and his wife, Thecla, had five children: Mary Lou '63, Aggie '66, Esther '68, Frank '70, and Charlie '71.

MARGE ROME '58 received a bachelor's degree in 1962 and a master's degree in 1967, both in elementary education at Fort Hays State University. She taught in Hays for one-half year at Jefferson East Elementary School, which is now Holy Family Elementary School. She began teaching in Victoria in 1962 and remained there until her retirement in 2001. She taught first grade for thirty-two and one-half years and kindergarten for seven years. In that time she taught a total of 788 students. She has two sisters: Rita Gross '47 and Mary Rome'65. She also has a niece and two nephews who are VHS alums: Janet Gross Trombley '73, Bob Gross '79, and Mike Gross '83.

BERNADETTE ROTH YOUNGER '58 received a Bachelor of Music Education from Mount St. Scholastica College in Atchison, Kansas, and later an elementary endorsement from Fort Hays State University. Her twenty-three-year teaching career started in Chase, Kansas, where she was the vocal music instructor in both the elementary and high school. She then taught fourth grade at Jefferson East Elementary School in Hays. Later, she taught music and a combination third, fourth, and fifth grade classroom at Walker. When the Walker school district was closed, Det joined the Victoria school district where she taught first, second, fourth, and fifth grades. Det retired in 2003 and is in her seventh year of substitute teaching from preschool to 12th grade classes including PE, art, and music. Det and her husband, Tom, have five children: Cathy '82, Amy '87, David '89, Blaine '98, and Beth '00. They also have eight grandchildren, including VHS alumna, Ashley Dreiling '03.
