## HALL OF FAME 2009

## SISTER ANNABEL DREILING, CSA ~ DAVID OTTLEY WILMA PFEIFER WELLBROCK VONLINTEL

It is with great pleasure that we, the Victoria Alumni Association, present the three following candidates to be named to the Victoria Alumni Association Hall of Fame for 2009. They are Sister Annabel Dreiling, David Ottley, and Wilma Pfeifer Wellbrock VonLintel. Sr. Annabel represents the devoted St. Agnes sisters that were such an important part of the early history of Victoria High School. David is the first elementary school principal and Wilma is the first school secretary to join the honored ranks of the Victoria High School Hall of Fame.

**SISTER ANNABEL DREILING, CSA** entered St. Agnes Convent in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, on August 1, 1922, at age 16. She made her final profession of vows on August 15, 1931. She received her bachelor of science degree in education and after many sessions of summer school earned her masters degree in modern and medieval history from Fordham University. She began her teaching career in New London, Wisconsin, then onto the Bronx in New York, then New York City and finally in 1944, she returned to her home town of Victoria, Kansas, to teach at Victoria Rural High School. She remained in Victoria until 1951. Sr. Annabel devoted 69 years of service to Catholic schools. She retired in 1994 at age 88.

**DAVID OTTLEY** is a Salina native, the fifth of seven children. After graduating from Salina Central High School, David attended and earned a bachelors degree in education and a masters degree in educational administration from Fort Hays State University. It was while attending Fort Hays that he met and married his wife, Andrea. David has spent his entire teaching and administrative career in Victoria. He taught 5<sup>th</sup> grade for 12 years and then moved onto middle school teaching reading and social science. He returned to the elementary school teaching 4<sup>th</sup> grade. The past 10 years he has taught 4<sup>th</sup> grade and assumed the duties of elementary principal. David or "Mr. O" as the children refer to him, is not only admired as a teacher and principal but touched many young lives as a coach. These duties included middle school football, basketball, volleyball, and boys' high school basketball. David spent a total of 20 years coaching for USD #432 and says these duties have proven to be one of his most memorable lifetime experiences. David and Andrea have three sons **Jordan '09**, who is attending Fort Hays State University, Brett 17, a senior at VHS, and Samuel 13, an 8<sup>th</sup> grade student at Victoria Middle School.

WILMA PFEIFER WELLBROCK VONLINTEL '51, an admired and loved high school secretary, was the youngest of 10 children. She attended grade school and high school in Victoria. After graduating from Victoria Rural High School in 1951, Wilma began working at the German American Telephone Company owned by Tony Denning. Many of you remember that voice answering our ring with "Number, please." Wilma married Milton Wellbrock '51 in November of 1955. He died January 16, 1981. She also worked for J.C. Penney Company and was the Victoria city clerk before beginning her secretarial work at Victoria High School. Wilma spent 23 years greeting the students with her smile and serving four high school principals beginning with Jim Pfanenstiel, then Richard Austin, Richard Shively and finally Michael Kreller. Wilma is married to Regis VonLintel '62 and has three sons Glenn Wellbrock '82, Leon Wellbrock '83, and Chris Wellbrock '85. Regis and Wilma have seven grandchildren.

# ANNOUNCING THE 2009 ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Brittany Goetz, daughter of Rod '82 and Maria Dreiling Goetz '86; Brenton Hoffman, son of Dave '82 and Brenda Braun Hoffman '83; Kasandra Huser, daughter of Kevin '84 and Kathleen Huser; and Jordan Ottley, son of David and Andrea Ottley, were selected by the Alumni Scholarship Committee to receive the 2009 Alumni Scholarships.

Each of these graduates received a \$500 scholarship to be awarded upon verification of enrollment at their chosen institutions. Scholarship applicants must be admitted into a post secondary school. This may be a four-year college or a two-year technical school. They must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5. The scholarship committee members base their selection on criteria that includes involvement in extra-curricular activities, honors, and awards. All applicants remain anonymous throughout the selection process and are identified by number only.

The first scholarship was awarded in 1994. The alumni association has awarded 56 scholarships as of May 2009, amounting to \$24,700.

These scholarships continue to be funded by your generous donations to the scholarship fund and the annual golf classic that takes place on Friday of homecoming weekend. Awarding of these scholarships is one of the main objectives of the alumni association.
