HALL OF FAME 2010

EVERETT J. BRAUN, DISTINGUISHED ALUM IVAN WERNER, TEACHER

It is with great pleasure that we, the Victoria Alumni Association, present the following candidates to be named to the Victoria Alumni Association Hall of Fame for 2010. They are Everett J Braun and Ivan Werner. Everett becomes the first person to be selected to receive the Distinguished Alum Award. Selected as a USD #432 recipient is Ivan Werner, who retired from USD #432 as a middle school teacher after many years of service. We are excited about our inductees. These gentlemen are very deserving of this prestigious award.

EVERETT BRAUN '60 was born July 9, 1942, to Ed and Minnie Braun. He was the youngest of three children. He attended grade school and high school in Victoria and later graduated from Fort Hays State University. Everett worked at Victoria Lumber Company, a family owned business, and eventually became owner of the business. The name Everett and music almost seem to be synonymous. He was well know as an accomplished musician and was especially proficient in the brass instruments and the keyboard. He was also blessed with a beautiful voice. He was a member of the St. Fidelis Catholic Church choir from his early days in grade school until his death. It was Everett playing the trumpet that sent many brides down the aisle and again the sharp tones of the trumpet echoing the ceremonial Taps as many soldiers and veterans were laid to rest. Everett served as a member of both the Victoria City Council and St. Fidelis Parish Council. He was a proud citizen of this country. His family, church, school, and community were of utmost importance to him. He married Judith Schmidtberger June 2, 1962, at St. Fidelis Church. They have three sons, Doug '82, Scott '91, and Curt '92; four grandsons, Brandon, Bryce, Coby, and Alec; and three granddaughters, Rachel, Isabel, and Adie. Everett was a loving brother to his siblings, Kenneth Braun '51 and Cora Braun Schulte '55.

WERNER is the oldest of six children of Edward and Susie Werner of Winona, Kansas. After graduation from Winona High School in 1954, Ivan attended Fort Hays State University. He earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration with certification to teach in 1958 and a Master of Business Administration in 1972. In the fall of 1958, he was employed by USD #314 in Brewster, Kansas, to teach Business Education and Economics. In June of 1960, he married Verda Goetz '55. In June of 1967, Ivan became executive secretary of the Kansas Council on Economic Education and an economics instructor at Kansas State University. In January of 1971, he began his career as a middle school teacher in Victoria USD #432 where he taught for 26½ years before retiring in July of 1997. He also taught one semester of high school mathematics in Victoria in the fall of 2001. Ivan states that if anyone had told him that he would teach at the middle school level, he would have assumed that they had lost their mind. However, once he started teaching these young people, he found them to be the most challenging and enjoyable age to teach. He also taught evening classes in accounting as an adjunct professor at Fort Hays State University for many years. Ivan and Verda have two daughters, Rhonda Fionda '79 and Patti Woschitz '80, and one son, Michael '91. Their grandchildren are Beth, Allison, and Nick Fionda and Luke and Jill Woschitz.

Homecoming 2010

Another homecoming weekend is fast approaching. September 17 and 18 are the dates set aside for VHS alumni to come home to celebrate the good times. All are welcome especially those class years ending with a zero or a five. The 50-year honor class is the Class of 1960. The Class of 1985 will be honored as the 25-year honor class and the Class of 2000 is the 10-year honor class. These three classes will be given the privilege of sharing treasured memories and current news about their respective class during the program following the banquet Saturday evening. All five-year-increment classes will be recognized. The 2010 Hall of Fame recipients, Everett Braun and Ivan Werner, will be honored at this time.

The weekend kicks off with the annual Victoria Alumni Scholarship Golf Classic. This year brings a change to the usual location. The tournament will take place at the Fort Hays Municipal Golf Course. The entry fee for this event will be \$40, which includes a lunch at the club house. Golf carts are available at a cost of \$25. All proceeds from the tournament will benefit the alumni scholarship fund.

The Victoria VFW Hall will be headquarters for all of Friday's events including open house before the parade and the social after the football game. The Memorial Mass will be celebrated on Saturday afternoon at 4:00 in St. Fidelis Catholic Church and will fulfill your Sunday obligation. The banquet, dinner, and dance will take place at the Fanchon Ballroom in Hays following Mass. This year you will have the privilege of dancing to a popular band from the area, "Sly Ridge".

The cost for the weekend will remain at \$25 per person plus your updated membership dues of \$5. This fee will entitle you to attend the social Friday evening and the social, banquet, and dance Saturday evening. You will find an enclosed envelope to return your dues and reservation form (found at the back of this newsletter) or you may print a form from the website.

If you are planning to attend only the Friday evening post game social at the VFW Hall and not attend any of the Saturday events, there will be a \$5 cover charge per person plus your current membership fee. Snacks, soft drinks, and beer will be provided.

ANNOUNCING THE 2010 ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Cara Braun, daughter of John '84 and Connie Braun; Andrew Karlin, son of Tom '83 and Saundra Meder Karlin '84; Joslyn Lang, daughter of Daren '83 and Dana Dreiling Lang '84; and Lindsey McAlonan, daughter of Aleck and Sandy Schmidtberger McAlonan '83, were selected by the Alumni Scholarship Committee to receive the 2010 Alumni Scholarships.

Each of these graduates received a \$500 scholarship to be awarded upon verification of enrollment at their chosen institutions. Scholarship applicants must be admitted into a post secondary school. This may be a four-year college or a two-year technical school. They must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5. The scholarship committee members base their selection on criteria that includes involvement in extra-curricular activities, honors, and awards. All applicants remain anonymous throughout the selection process and are identified by number only.

The first scholarship was awarded in 1994. The Alumni Association has awarded 60 scholarships as of May 2010, amounting to \$26,700.

These scholarships continue to be funded by your generous donations to the scholarship fund and the annual golf classic that takes place on Friday of homecoming weekend. This year the board of directors has opted to have a raffle along with the golf tournament to support the scholarship fund. Awarding of these scholarships is one of the main objectives of the Alumni Association.
