worked with Western Plains Service Corp., a subsidiary of Golden Belt Bank. Western Plains has been developing residential lots in the area for more than 35 years. They have been looking at Victoria for some time and feel like it has some very positive potential with the close proximity to Hays, the grocery store reopening, and the new addition to the high school.

The addition has been approved for the Rural Housing Incentive Act intended to encourage housing development in rural areas. Under these guidelines, the developer pays the costs up front. Western Plains will be responsible, and not the city.

The investment is returned as the lots are sold and

houses are built. The developer will receive the taxes on the properties until it recovers costs or 15 years, whichever comes first, rather than the county, city, and school district. Property assessment remains the same. Homeowners will not be assessed for specials because the developer has put in the infrastructure.

Lots are priced from \$11,000 to \$14,000 and if a lot is purchased a home must be built within two years. The land will be developed in three phases and will have homes on 41 single family lots. Phase one has 17 lots, phase two 12 lots, and phase three 12 lots.
