HALL OF FAME 2012

FR. MIKE SCULLY, O.F.M. CAP., TEACHER
RUBY SCHUMACHER ROTH, DIETICIAN/COOK, POSTHUMOUS
ALLEN DREILING, DISTINGUISHED ALUM

FR. MICHAEL SCULLY

was born to Clay and Edna Scully in Ohio where they resided for a few years. At the



age of two, his family moved to West to Virginia where he spent his childhood days. He has a sister, Sid, and two

nephews and one niece. Fr. Mike, as we know him best, entered the seminary at age 13. He was ordained into the Capuchin Franciscan Order in 1965. He attended St. Fidelis College in Herman, Pennsylvania, receiving a degree in philosophy. He obtained a master's degree in theology from Capuchin College in Washington, D.C. He began his studies in mathematics at Catholic University in Washington, D.C., and completed his master's degree in mathematics at Fort Hays State College. The Victoria community first got to know Fr. Mike back in 1978 when he was named pastor of St. Fidelis parish. He remained in Victoria until 1982. Before his return in 2007, he filled various positions including the following: vocation director in the Kansas City area, the first Capuchin pastor in Lawrence, administrator of Thomas More Prep, provincial of the Capuchin Province of Mid-America for 6 years, and then back to Victoria once again to take over the reins as pastor of St. Fidelis Church. It was during this time that Fr. Mike consented to teach mathematics at Victoria High School. He taught calculus, advanced math, and geometry. Besides his duties as pastor, he taught Bible studies to the sixth grade religion class as well as senior religion. He has been a keynote speaker at the annual student council camp in

Emporia since 1970. His presentation, "Rock Music and Leadership," has been presented to over 30,000 young people. His radio show, "Message at the Top", is o n KJLS-FM, Mix103.3 aired [www.mix103fm.com] in Hays, and can be listened to online on Sunday mornings from 10 a.m. to 12 noon. His book, The Message of Youth, is a Christian resource book for parents and youth ministers and is a must-read for all parents. Father Mike is currently serving as vocation director in the Lawrence and Kansas City area. Students at Victoria High School were privileged to have Fr. Mike as a math teacher from 2007 thru 2011. During those four years, he was an encouraging presence at VHS to both students and faculty.

RUBY SCHUMACHER

ROTH '32 was born to Henry and Pauline Schumacher in Victoria. She was the oldest of ten children. She received a



teaching certificate from Fort Havs School Normal (predecessor to Fort Hays State College). She taught school in rural Rooks County in the Zurich area and in rural Ellis

County for a number of years. She also worked for a period of time at the government ASCS farm office in Hays. Ruby married Alphonse (Oscar) Roth September 18, 1944, in Pfeifer. They lived on a farm west of Pfeifer and farmed in the Pfeifer area their entire married life. Her true cooking career began with helping to cook for her brothers and sisters. Four of her surviving siblings are

Norman Schumacher **'**45, Leland Schumacher '46, Jeanette Schumacher Younger '50, and Paula Schumacher Palerno '56. Her specialty was delicious pastries and wedding cakes which she made for family and friends over the years. Ruby started sharing her cooking expertise with the public in 1965 when she accepted a position as "Pie Baker" at the Vagabond Motel in Hays. She worked in this capacity for four years. Ruby began the job which she dearly loved and it was a perfect match for her in 1969 when she became the Meal Planner for the Victoria School district. This job blended her love for cooking with the love she had for kids. She spent many hours planning the menus to utilize the commodities the district received to create meals the students would truly enjoy. There was nothing quite like Ruby's bierocks. She worked in this capacity for the remainder of her career. Ruby and Oscar had three sons, Wayne '64, Allen '65, and Tom '67.

ALLEN P. DREILING

'55 is the youngest son of Alphonse and Melosina Dreiling. He grew up in Victoria and attended Victoria Grade School and Victoria High School. He attended Fort Hays State College and Salt City Business College in Hutchison. From May 1958 to May 1972, Allen was employed by A.W. Burtscher, Public Accountant, and R.N.

Burtscher, C.P.A., in public accounting in Hays. In May of 1972, Allen started his own business, Dreiling Accounting Inc., located at the corner of



4th and Main. Allen and his wife **Connie Brungardt Dreiling '53** were married in
Victoria and have three children, **Wanda Dreiling Karlin '76, Cletus Dreiling '79,** and **Sandra Dreiling Budke '80**. Allen has
served the city of Victoria throughout the
years. He was elected to the Victoria City
Council from 1985 to 1993 and then was
elected mayor from May of 1993 until
May of 1999. He served as a school board
member and a St. Fidelis parish council
member from 1972 to 1976. He was

appointed to the church finance council and served for eleven years. He was an incorporator of the Cathedral of the Plains Charitable Fund in 1989 and currently serves on the board of directors. Allen was influential in getting the alumni association started. He was one of the first members of the board of directors when the association began in 1993. The alumni golf tournament, on the sand greens in Victoria, came about because of Allen's persistence and hard work. His love for

the game and the camaraderie of his fellow alumni find him at every tournament since its inception. If he is not golfing, he is there to help in any way he can. ANNOUNCING THE 2012 ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS
