These three classes will be given the privilege of sharing treasured memories and current news about their respective classes during the program following the banquet Saturday evening. All five-year-increment classes will be recognized. The 2013 Hall of Fame recipients, **Randy Stanley, Kathalie Dortland Hoffman**, and **Arlene Wellbrock Pfeifer** will be honored at this time.

The weekend kicks off with the annual Victoria Alumni Scholarship Golf Classic. The tournament will take place at Fort Hays Municipal Golf Course. All proceeds from the tournament will benefit the alumni scholarship fund.

The Victoria V.F.W. will be headquarters for all of Friday's events including open house before the parade and the social after the football game. The Memorial Mass will be celebrated on Saturday afternoon at 3:00 in St. Fidelis Church, fulfilling the Sunday obligation. This year you will have the privilege of dancing to Anthony & the Anamals, whose band members are many of our VHS Alumni.

Gene Dreiling has officially retired after 42 years of service to Victoria Public Schools. He began teaching at Victoria in 1971. Some of his fellow teachers during his first years at VHS were Jerry Cronister, Pat O'Brien, Lawrence Marcotte, Tony "Red" Pfeifer, and Benny Schulte. Mr. Dreiling was the English department at Victoria High School. He taught English literature, grammar, logic, and speech and was a sponsor to a variety of school organizations. He remembers sitting on the back of a pick-up truck on the visitor side of the football field to give the play-byplay of the football games.

Mr. Dreiling was respected by his colleagues and his students. He was among the first three teachers to be inducted into the Victoria Alumni Hall of Fame in 2002. It is not unusual to hear graduates of Victoria High School say that Mr. Dreiling was one of their best teachers. Only time made them realize the value of hours spent in Mr. Dreiling's classroom.

HALL OF FAME 2013

RANDY STANLEY, TEACHER KATHALIE DORTLAND HOFFMAN '63, TEACHER ARLENE WELLBROCK PFEIFER '50, TEACHER & DISTINGUISHED ALUM

RANDY STANLEY was born

in Parsons, Kansas, on October 6, 1954, to Lyle and Nadine Stanley. Randy lived his first 18 years in Herington, Kansas. His



father was a parts salesman for John Deere and later International Harvester in Herington, and his mother was a homemaker n а d

seamstress at Paragon Sewing Factory in Herington. Randy enjoyed his childhood with his wonderful parents and his older brother, Danny. College was a lengthy adventure for Randy beginning in 1972 at Butler County Community College and finishing with a master's degree from Fort Hays State University in 1992. There were many detours involving a long hair beach life in southern California, to a mountain ski adventure in Colorado. Both alternative life styles consumed 10 to 12 years of Randy's younger life. While in Colorado, he decided to return to Fort Hays to pursue his master's degree. During this time he was a graduate assistant track coach at the college. Randy was hired by the Victoria School District in 1993 to fill the position left by Vernon Berens '53. He taught science at the middle school for several years and is currently teaching physical education and coaching track and cross country at Victoria High School. Randy brought cross country back to VHS in the Fall of 2007. Since then, the cross country team has qualified for state every year but one. This past year, the Victoria High School team took 3rd at state along with several individual medalists. Randy was named Coach of the Year in Cross Country in 2012

and Coach of the Year in track in 2010. As track coach, Mr. Stanley is determined to find the best events to showcase a student's strongest athletic abilities. He is a constant support and friend to all students in all their high school activities whether sport or non-sporting events. Randy cherishes the teachers he has had the honor of working with in his beginning years as well as the friendships he has made while teaching in the Victoria school system. She organized neighborhood Christmas pageants presented at St. John's Rest Home and lead Cub Scout dens, all between driving her children to dance lessons, music lessons, sporting activities, and summer programs offered by Fort Hays College. Arlene began teaching in the Victoria school system in 1974. Her tenure lasted 23 years teaching 4th grade, kindergarten, and Title I students. When the junior high school was in danger of discontinuing girls' volleyball because of the lack of an available coach, Arlene stepped up. Despite limited experience in coaching volleyball, she dedicated her time to the program as an assistant coach because she could not bear to see the program

fade away. She learned alongside the girls in the program, yet provided leadership and ensured them the sporting opportunity she knew to be so valuable to childhood development. Arlene continually instilled the value of education to her children and now her grandchildren and to this day encourages them to find time for formal education. 2013 Alumni SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Seventy-three VHS seniors have benefited from alumni scholarships since its beginning in 1993. Monies awarded in scholarships have reached \$37,700.

The VHS Scholarship awarded each year at graduation has gone from one \$200 scholarship to four \$1,000 scholarships. This increase is due entirely to the generosity of all of our alumni. Awarding of these scholarships is one of the main objectives of the alumni association.

The following seniors have been awarded \$1,000 scholarships for 2013.

Lane Braun, son of Rick '82 and Janice Braun; Sarah Kuhn, daughter of Joe '73 and Diane Sanders Kuhn '83; Michael Lang, son of Allen '85 and Christine Lang; and Ashley Wellbrock, daughter of Leon '83 and Joan Wellbrock, were selected by the Alumni Scholarship Committee to receive the 2013 Alumni Scholarships.

Each of these graduates received a \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded upon verification of enrollment at their chosen institutions. Scholarship applicants must be admitted into a post secondary school. This may be a four-year college or a two-year technical school. They must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5. The scholarship committee members base their selection on criteria that includes involvement in extra-curricular activities, honors, and awards. All applicants remain anonymous throughout the selection process and are identified by number only.

The entry fee is \$40 per player (same as last year) payable at registration. The format is a 4-Person Scramble. Carts will be available to rent for \$20 payable to the pro shop at the golf course. Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams. There will be hole prizes also. No cash prizes, this is a fundraiser! Registration starts at 8:00 AM and shot gun start at 9:00 AM.

GOLF TOURNAMENT

"What do I get for my \$40?" you ask. I am glad you asked. To start with, we will have coffee and rolls at registration, 18 holes of golf on a really nice golf course, lunch in the club house, and free beverages provided by the finest beverage cart personnel that the alumni board can afford. We never know who will volunteer to drive the beverage cart, but you can be sure that they will have as much fun as the golfers. There will be souvenirs and prizes for everyone and fun, lots of fun. I play in several tournaments each year and not one comes close to the VHS AGT. Obviously there is a special connection among the golfers as most of us are VHS alums but it goes deeper than that alone. There are several teams that have played together for a number of years and there are honor classes that put together teams for the first time. Corporate sponsorship requires a minimum donation of \$100. We also need prizes and give-a-ways for the golfers. All sponsors and prize donors will be acknowledged on the VHS website.

Now is the time to get your teams together and plan your strategy to take out last year's champions Mark Robben, Rod Goetz, Darren Dinkel, and Ray Bombardier. We all know they just plain got lucky. They are very unlikely to repeat! (Now that's trash talk!) Honor classes, this is a great opportunity to start your special weekend by putting a team together and join in the fun. 
