

only spent two years in Victoria, but according to Cora, it was obvious that our little town holds a special place in his heart.

After finishing the regular season 8-10, the Knights began district play by defeating Dorrance and then Ransom. Next was the district championship versus Quinter. Quinter was able to defeat the Knights 40-39 in the VHS gym, but the second place finish was good enough to advance to the regional championship at Sheridan Coliseum in Hays.

At Sheridan, the Knights first defeated Almena, then Natoma, and that led to a rematch with Quinter. This time the Knights were victorious by a final score of 58-56.

The State Tournament for Victoria was held in Hutchinson. Their first round opponent was a team from Howard with 23 wins and one loss. After getting acclimated to glass backboards, which none of the VHS team had ever seen before, the Knights were able to settle in for a 59 to 48 victory. In the semifinals, our team was defeated by eventual State champion Partridge 50-44. The boys from Victoria were able to right the ship for the consolation game, and they defeated Baldwin 71-56 to bring home what is believed to be Victoria's first State placement in any sport in school history.
